Kroyer, P.S. Kroyer was the most famous and influential young artist of the "golden era" painters, during the 1880s-1890s. Kroyer became a synonym for the great "golden era" artists of the fishing community "Skagen," an international venue for young artists.

At the very tip of northern Jutland, in Denmark he was a naturalistic plein air painter, but accepted no boundaries in producing his art.

His painting reflects the very atmosphere and quality that accompany the changing seasons at Skagen.

Spanish painter Sorolla felt that Kroyer really gave France, Italy and Spain its appreciation of painting "the northern light." P. S. Kroyer received world-wide fame with exhibitions in Venice, Paris, Berlin, Vienna & Chicago in the late 1800s. The style of some of his paintings showed similarities to the work of Spanish artist Diego Velázquez.
